3. Updates from NPUA Exec/EHUSSC

The possibility of umpire exchanges was discussed at EHUSSC and agreed they need to be two way. UDP and U4E opportunities may be possible if opportunities arise. Will look for opportunities for season '24/25. ACTION: HJ/LK to discuss with EHF contacts and revert/discuss to EHUSSC. RJ to advise HJ on draft double headers as soon as known.

Key Characteristics for Umpiring Support will be rolled out at Conference ACTION: EHUSSC to discuss at its next meeting

Two development groups have been held for umpire support; a virtual event based on analising a match, and then a group attended Cup Finals Day, where matches were reviewed based on Umpiring Key Characteristics and the Support Key Characteristics were discussed and observerd

NPUA Conference '24/25 is confirmed for $7/8^{th}$ September in Nottingham at the Jubilee Hotel and conference centre. Details were shared with members via GMS on May 3rd. An exciting agenda is planned, and the conference will be open to EHO members on day 2. ACTION: All members to sign up as soon as possible

5. Coaching & Assessing Update

MJ provided a full update on season 23/24.

With increased umpire support numbers, this season has been a very good one, both in terms of supporting the panel umpires and those candidates put forward by the areas. We have seen a significant rise in the number of assessments, offering more progression between the panels, coupled with a record number of candidates being assessed.

6. Appointments Update - RJ/CP/CB/LP/LB

CP: First half went well, but availability slightly dipped with grateful thanks to areas helping. RJ: Dates where all games are on the same day still a struggle, but noted these are less than before. Late games require some umpire travel/welfare consideration, often making us look more regionally at appointments whilst still avoiding too many same-club appointments.

End of season Cup finals went well. Thanks to all those who supported.

The BUCs season also went well, with enjoyable finals. Thanks to Julian Warburton for the excellent organisation.

7. Panel discussion (all):

As a reminder to members, EHUOPC noted that when measuring performance for panel promotions, marks from prior seasons also form part of the overall consideration. The guidance for A star, is that two marks of 9 or 10 on Prem games is needed for promotion and usually 'within' a season, with final ratification of promotion based on continuously high performance, with final ratification required by EHUOPC. Membership on both A star and B star panels is over a maximum of two full seasons.

Movement between panels - it was acknowledged that there needs to be more fluidity to enable progression for those performing well, and those who do not, especially on the star panels. The marking system has clarity around the bands required, and should be referred to by umpires, as well as assessors regularly. Outside of the marking system, EHUOPC has authority from NPUA Executive to move umpires between panels, and may from time to time make changes outside the bands..

As a reminder to members that active Premier or A star panel, on the panel at the Christmas break, need to have completed a second fitness test to Premier level, one of which needs to be in person. Those without two fitness tests will not be appointed to Premier League matches

Exceptions to the above notes are in the gift of EHUOPC.

Taking a Break from Umpiring (Extract from the 2023/24 Fitness test policy)

Annual assessment is all about maintaining standards for elite national level umpiring. If an umpire takes a break it is essential to NPUA that when they return to umpiring they are fit to do so.



If a member has, for whatever reason, taken a break from umpiring (lasting longer than the current season) they will need to demonstrate their fitness and be re-assessed when they resume umpiring.

It should not be automatically assumed that the member would return to the panel they were on at the start of the absence, particularly if that absence was fitness related.

Those members who are inactive due to injury or a failed fitness test will continue to fall under the responsibility of their original panel lead, this will continue until such time as they return to umpiring or fall into the long-term break described below.

For clarity, and subject to the discretion of the Performance Committee to take into account individual circumstances, the following will apply:

- Short-term break (within the current season having passed a fitness test at the start of the season) return to existing panel, no assessment required (although a fitness test may be required at the discretion of the panel lead)
- Medium-term break (within the current season plus the following season) fitness test
 required, then assessed and returned to the C panel (outdoor) or B panel (indoor), with
 Indoor / Outdoor Performance Committee discretion to reinstate at any panel following
 the initial assessment. Such a decision can be agreed by the relevant Performance
 Committee off-cycle from their formal meeting schedule
- Long-term break (greater than the current season plus the following season) umpire should undertake games in their Area, pass the NPUA fitness test for a candidate, and then be re-nominated by their Area as a candidate

Panel updates:

All panel leads provided comprehensive updates to panels during the meeting. Notable highlights are below.

Umpires who have not umpired in the NPUA league progamme for 12 months will be moved to the reserve panel. Return to 'old' panel possible subject to performance, with fitness test for the panel and following assessment on an appropriate game.

Reserve umpires (and umpire support) who have not taken NPUA appointments for 18 months will be removed from NPUA panels. Return to NPUA umpiring is possible with Area nominations.

Umpires without appropriate fitness tests for panels will be moved to appropriate panel for test or to reserves. Return to 'old' panel is possible if the correct level test is achieved with an appropriate mark for the panel.
